Learning to Live Together is an interfaith and intercultural programme for ethics education, developed by the Interfaith Council on Ethics Education for Children in close collaboration with UNESCO and UNICEF. It is a programme for educators (teachers, youth leaders, social workers) to support children and youth in strengthening their identity and critical thinking, their ability to make well grounded decisions and to work with people of other cultures and religions. Learning to Live Together was developed during a period of three years through testing workshops organized by the Global Network of Religions for Children (GNRC) around the world with people of different faiths and secular backgrounds. Now it is run in various countries around the world. In Tanzania the programme is coordinated by GNRC, the Tanzanian partner organization in this exchange.
